In App Notice for Auditors Without Audit Profiles

Overview

To view reports to audit, auditors must have the appropriate role and an audit profile assigned. For auditors who do not have an audit profile assigned but can still log in to Verify, a notice now displays to explain why the filters are disabled, and what is required in order to view reports pending an audit.

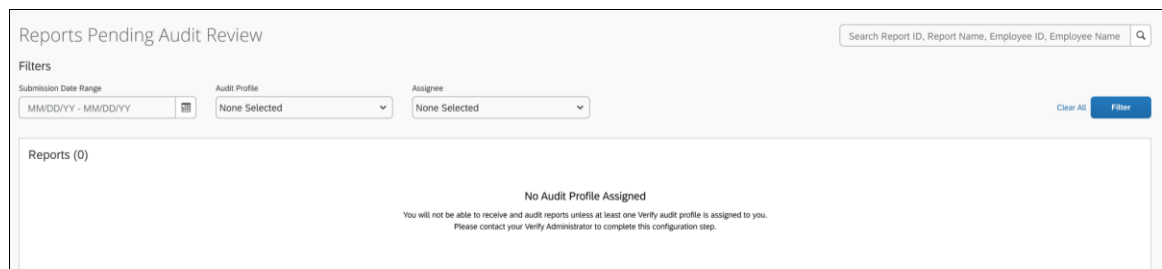
BUSINESS PURPOSE / CLIENT BENEFIT

The notice provides clarity for auditors without assigned profiles whenever they do not see reports to audit as expected.

What the User Sees
