

# **– Concur Travel \* Client Fact Sheet – Worldspan Fare Store Changes February 26 2020**

(applies to Professional and Standard Travel)

## **Overview**

Over many years, SAP Concur has supported several options around fare storing for Worldspan. This has presented a high level of complexity for Worldspan PNR support. Recently, SAP Concur has seen that some of the legacy options are not well suited to work with newer industry faring, such as the **Exclude Unbundled Economy Fares** option (FXD modifier).


To reduce support costs and to ensure SAP Concur is using the most up-to-date pricing methods for our Worldspan customers, SAP Concur has made several changes.

**NOTE:** Due to other higher priority initiatives, the remaining two settings will not be updated until further notice.

Using the **Pricing Options** section of the Worldspan travel configuration for reference:

<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	Use #TR on fare quote

- **Use #PI on fare quote:** SAP Concur plans to remove this option and stop doing this for all customers. Travelport has advised this is a legacy option that is no longer commonly used.

---

**NOTE:** Although this setting remains in place, SAP Concur will no longer accept Support cases for issues with the use of #PI. Any new Support cases will be closed with the guidance to migrate to using #TR.

---

- **Use #TR on fare quote:** SAP Concur plans to remove this option and always use #TR for all stored fares.

## FAQ

**Q.** Which Worldspan Pricing Options travel configuration settings are already retired, and when did those changes occur?

**A.** The following settings have been retired:

1. **Skip 4P\* (USE WITH CAUTION):** SAP Concur has removed this option with the January 2020 release.
2. **Use FSR for general fare store (no discount code):**  
SAP Concur has removed this option with the July 2019 release.
3. **Use FEX instead of FSR for Securate Pricing:** SAP Concur has removed this option with the May 2017 release.
